Truth #1. The Righteous Life

Psalm 1:6 The Lord watches over the way of the righteous.

Psalm 5:12 For surely, O Lord, You bless the righteous.

Psalm 34:15, 17, 19 The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry; The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles. A righteous man may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all..."

Truth #2. The Righteous Life

Psalm 37:25, 29, 39 I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread. The righteous will inherit the land and dwell in it forever. The salvation of the righteous comes from the LORD; he is their stronghold in time of trouble.

Psalm 55:2 Cast your cares on the LORD and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous fall.

Psalm 72:7 In his days the righteous will flourish...

Psalm 112:4, 6 Even in darkness light dawns for the upright, for the gracious and compassionate and righteous man. Surely he will never be shaken; a righteous man will be remembered forever.

Proverbs 11:7 When a wicked man dies, his hope perishes; all he expected from his power comes to nothing.

Genesis 18:23-26: Then Abraham approached him and said: "Will you sweep away the righteous with the wicked? What if there are fifty righteous people in the city? Will you really sweep it away and not spare the place for the sake of the fifty righteous people in it? Far be it from you to do such a thing—to kill the righteous with the wicked, treating the righteous and the wicked alike. Far be it from you! Will not the Judge of all the earth do right?"

The LORD said, "If I find fifty righteous people in the city of Sodom, I will spare the whole place for their sake."

Genesis 18:32 "Then he said, 'May the Lord not be angry, but let me speak just once more. What if only ten can be found there?' He answered, 'For the sake of ten, I will not destroy it.'"

Matthew 11:23-24 "And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted up to the skies? No, you will go down to the depths. If the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Sodom, it would have remained to this day. But I tell you that it will be more bearable for Sodom on the day of judgment than for you."

2 Chronicles 7:14. "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land."
